SAFARI ADVENTURE CAMP AGES 7-11

Kids start a new adventure each day of this five day session. Adventures include:

Release and Assumption of Risk Agreement

It has been explained to me, _____ (parent/guardian) for _____ (participant) and I fully understand that during his/her visit to the Wild Things Animal Rentals Inc. compound located on the Vision Quest Ranch in Salinas, California, to participate in the Summer Safari program, wild/exotic animals will in fact be in close proximity to all participants and their belongings. There will at times be no barriers between them. I understand that although many precautions will be taken to prevent any accidents from occurring, wild/exotic animals can at times be dangerous and unpredictable. I further understand that these factors are often beyond anyone’s control. I sign this release knowing that property could be damaged by or participants could be injured by one of these animals. I have inquired about all activities the participant will be involved with, which animals will be involved in those activities, any foods or beverages my child will receive and I have read the document, Summer Safari / Roar & Snore Requirements for Parents and Summer Safari Registration Form. Having done so, I agree to let the above participant participate in such activities and adhere to the conditions listed in such documents.

I realize that the program “Summer Safari” is not a professional still photo or video shoot. I agree to the following terms pertaining to video or still photos shot by participants or their parents or guardians while at the Wild Things Animal Rentals Inc. compound: Photos or video footage taken by myself, by fellow participants, by Wild Things associates, or by anyone else, of the animals or of myself or one of the participants with or of the animals, are for my own personal use and enjoyment and may not be used in any way commercially or professionally and such photos or video footage will not be released to any form of media (TV or Print), activist group, club, association or govt. agency without the express written permission of Charlie Sammut, owner of Wild Things Animal Rentals Inc.

I understand that there is in fact poison oak on the ranch and although every attempt will be made by camp directors to minimize the risk of participant being near such plants, there is always the possibility that participants will still come in contact with it. I understand that I am to be at the Vision Quest Ranch promptly at the camp’s scheduled start time to drop off the participant and back again at the Vision Quest Ranch to retrieve that participant at the scheduled end time and will be charged at rate of \$25.00 for every 1/2 hour entered that I am late picking up the participant which will be due on the day such fees are incurred.

I _____ being the legal parent/guardian for _____ having read and understanding the explanation of the possible risks and dangers involved with the “Summer Safari” program agree to allow _____ to participate in the program and in doing so, I have and do hereby assume all risk and hereby release Wild Things Animal Rentals Inc., and all those acting as its agents or associates, Oxtan Kennels , and all those acting as its agents or associates, E.A.R.S. Inc., and all those acting as its agents or associates, Vision Quest Ranch, and all those acting as its agents or associates, Charlie Sammut and all those acting as his agents or associates and will hold them harmless from any and all liability, actions, causes of actions, debts, claims, and demands of every kind and nature whatsoever which I now have or which may arise of or in connection with the program, Summer Safari. The terms hereof shall serve as a release and assumption of risk for myself, my heirs, executors, and administrators, and for all members of my family.

Wild Things Animal Rentals Inc. and all those acting as its’ agents or associates disclaims any and all warranties implied or expressed pertaining to the performance of its animals.

In the event agents or associates of Wild Things Animal Rentals Inc. feel the participant(s) is or becomes a threat or danger to the health and well being of other participants, the animals, or him or herself or a disruption to the program in general that is beyond the scope of reasonable behavior, those agents or associates reserve the right to terminate the excursion for that participant and participant will surrender the full program fee.

Medical Release: I _____ authorize the agents of Wild Things Animal Rentals Inc. to seek any medical attention they deem necessary for my child. I have listed any and all preexisting medical conditions, needs, allergies, etc. on the Summer Safari Registration form document. I understand that upon the need for such medical attention, Wild Things agents will first attempt to contact me using the numbers I have left them on the registration form. Should that attempt meet with negative results, they will attempt to contact the emergency contact I have listed on the registration form. I will make sure that such phone numbers are current, correct and valid and understand that it is my responsibility to edit such information should it change on a daily basis. Should all attempts to contact someone meet with negative result, I authorize Wild Things agents to transport my child to any medical facility they deem necessary to receive any medical attention they deem necessary.

Recommendations for Parents

Welcome to Wild Things Safari Camp 2009! Here are just a few recommendations and guidelines for parents/guardians that will help their child have the most rewarding experience at camp!

- If your child does not complete camp for any reason (to include weather, illness, phobias, etc.), camp fees will not be refunded. Our camps completely fill up and we end up turning children away, & we do have expenses prior to camp, such as crafts, snacks, etc. Filling one of these spaces is at the above mentioned risks to the participant and parents.
- Layered clothing is recommended. Although we expect the weather to be warm, it can get chilly in the mornings.
- We also recommend that you apply sunscreen to your child before arriving at camp. We are in a valley and usually have a cool breeze, but the sun is still very hot. A hat and sunglasses are not a bad idea either. (Please note that Wild Things cannot be responsible for the loss or breakage of such items.)
- Footwear should be of a supportive, non-slip, leather or canvas nature with socks (i.e. high or low top tennis shoes or hiking boots). No sandals of any kind will be allowed. Children are not allowed to bring pocketknives, toys, radios or expensive jewelry to camp. If your child would like to bring a camera, we highly recommend the disposable type to avoid loss or damage of expensive equipment.
- You must provide a complete sack lunch for your child. We can refrigerate the lunch but do not pack anything that requires heating. No glass please. We will provide drinks, such as fruit punch, and an afternoon snack. There is a soda machine available if you would like to provide your camper with change (\$1.50).
- Doors will open at 9:50 a.m. Camp will begin promptly at 10 a.m. Please make sure your child is on time. It is difficult to expect 20+ young and excited campers to wait for latecomers. If for some reason you are running late or your child will not be attending camp a certain day please call ahead to let us know at 831-455-1901 ext 3.
- When dropping campers off, **authorized parents/guardians must sign in their child and provide proof of identification**. When picking campers up **authorized parents/guardians must also sign campers out with proof of identification (NO EXCEPTIONS)**. Please do not send your children into camp without you and do not ask them to meet you at the car after camp is done. For the safety of the children, campers will **ONLY** be released to authorized adults on their registration applications. Please note that for every half-hour entered that you are late picking up your child you will be charged a \$25.00 fee.

Recommendations for Parents

Roar & Snore Overnight Camp is from 3 p.m. – 10 a.m. for Safari Adventure campers and 4:30 p.m. – 10 a.m. for non-campers. Roar & Snore Overnight camp includes tent accommodations, dinner, campfire snack, breakfast, and a Wild Things souvenir.

To make your child's stay enjoyable please familiarize yourself with the following information as you plan your child's special night. Also please remember, your child will be sleeping in a tent under the stars, and they may hear animal sounds unfamiliar to them, so please prepare them accordingly!

What to Bring

Each camper needs to bring the following items labeled with his/her name. Keep in mind that campers will be responsible for their own gear.

- Sleeping bag and pillow (cots are not provided)
- Pajamas or sweat suit
- Jacket
- Change of clothes for the following day
- Comfortable shoes
- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Personal toiletries: comb/brush, etc. (We cannot dispense medications)
- Blow dryers or electrical appliances are NOT permitted
- Towel and wash cloth
- There are no showers but restroom facilities will be available at all times.

Items People May Wish To Bring:

- Thick foam pad (Mattresses, roll-away beds, or cots are not permitted)
- Disposable camera or camera with extra film
- Food (only in case of dietary necessity)
- Extra blanket
- Sunscreen

Please Leave the Following Items at Home:

- Valuables
- Hand-held electronic games
- Portable TVs, iPods, MP3 Players
- Flip-flop sandals
- Pocket knives
- Candles
- Pets
